FOR THE FIRST TIME IN INDIA HIGH COURT OF TRIPURA
COMES WITH A CONCEPT OF CASHLESS UNIQUE SECURITY
COURT FEES CARD

Agartala, Feb 10: Today i.e. 10.02.2023 at 10.00 am in the High Court lobby **Hon'ble Mr. Justice T. Amarnath Goud, Chief Justice (Acting), High Court of Tripura** in presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Arindam Lodh has discussed and suggested for launching of **unique cashless Court Fees Payment Debit Card system** which will have direct access only with the High Court and the Bank and on swiping the card for payment of Court Fees the name of the Advocate will appear and the purpose for which the card is swiped will also appear in the print-out receipt. This card will be exclusively used for Court Fees transaction having connectivity with the High Court, UCO Bank and the lawyer. It cannot be used by any other lawyer or any other person even if the said card is lost or theft is taken place.

This concept of cashless unique security card for Court Fees transaction has been mooted for the first time in India.

Today's programme was well attended by Advocates, High Court employees and UCO Bank staff in presence of Hon'ble Chief Justice (Acting) and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Arindam Lodh and everyone has appreciated and felt that it will be a very user friendly concept and after making fine tuning to the proposal very shortly this will come into execution.
