#### NOTIFICATION

The Governor of Tripura is pleased to make the following rules to regulate training in Eurvey and Settlement and for matters incidental thereto, namely:—

### 1. SHORT TITLE, COMMENCEMENT & APPLICATION

- (i) These rules may be called the Tripura Survey and Settlement (Training & Examination) Rules, 1986.
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
- (iii) These rules shall apply to in service personnels holding the post of Kanungo, Revenue Inspector, Surveyor, Amin and Tehsilder under the Government.

#### 2. DEFINITION

In these rules unless the context otherwise requires

- (a) "Course" means the course appended to these rules;
- (b) "Director" means Head of the Department of the Directorate of Land Records & Settlement, Government of Tripura;

- (c) "Examination" means the final examination both—
  practical and theoretical on completion of a training course;
- (d) "Government" means Government of Tripura;
- (c) "Officer-in-charge" means Officer-in-charge of a training programme of the Survey Training Institute;
- (f) "Principal" means the Head of the Survey Training Institute;
- (g) "Schedule" means the schedule appended to these Rules;
- (h) "Survey Training Institute" means Survey Training Institute under the Directorate of Land Records & Settlement.;
- (i) "Test" means the assessment to be made on completion of each subject or group of subjects;
- (j) "Trainee" means in-service per sonnels under the Government-

#### 3. SELECTION OF TRAINEES:

The selection of trainees shall be made on the basis of seniority in the respective department of the Government subject to the final selection made by the Principal.

#### 4. STIPEND AND TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES:

- (1) The period of training and examination of a trainee shall be treated as on duty. Besides the normal pay and allowances a trainee shall be entitled to a stipend of Rs. 90.00 per month for the period of training and examination.
- (2) A trainee shall be entitled to travelling allowances as on tour to join the training course and for return journey on completion of training.
  - (3) No stipend shall be admissible to a trainee while on leave other than casual leave. In case a trainee discontinues the training course for reasons beyond his control or is withdrawn from the training course by the parent department in the interest of public services he may be allowed to undergo the full training course subsequently and he shall be eligible for the stipend for subsequent full training course.
  - (4) The Director shall be the stipend sanctioning authority but the same will be paid to the trainees by the respective departments from their own budget.

# 5. DURATION AND NO. OF TRAINEES OF DIFFERENT TRAINING COURSES:

The training course to be conducted by the Survey Training Institute, duration of training course, session and number of trainees to be trained per batch are as follows:—

#### 6. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The medium of instruction of all the training courses shall be either Bengali or English.

#### 7. EXAMINATION AND PUBLICATION OF RESULTS:

- (1) The examination shall be held on completion of each of the prescribed courses.
- (2) The Principal shall conduct the examination at Agartala and fix-up date/dates and programme of examination.
- (3) The periodical test will be conducted by Officer in-chrage after completion of the training in each subject or group of subjects and communicate the assessment report of each trainee to the Principal and also to the concerned trainee.
- (4) The Principal shall notify the dates of examination at least 15 days before the examination begins.
- (5) For passing the examination a trainee must obtain at least 40% marks in individual theorical and practical papers and 45% marks in the aggregate. For passing examination with distinction, a trainee must obtain at least 60% marks in the aggregate.
- (6) A trainee who could not pass the examination at the first instance shall have to appear in the subsequent examinations at his own cost and admissible leave. He shall be given opporunity to pass the examination within 3 subsequent examinations.
- (7) The Principal shall publish the result and send the same to the respective Heads of Departments of the trainee immediately after publication of the result showing the marks obtained by each trainee in each paper.
- (8) A trainee who has failed in the examination but has obtained at least 50% marks in any paper, he shall be exempted from appearing in that paper in subsequent examinations.

(9) A tranee who discontinues the training course deliberately or without valid ground or who fails to pass the examination even after 3 successive chances as provided in the sub-rule (8), the entire cost of training shall be recovered from him. The amount of such cost shall be decided by the Principal whose decision shall be final.

#### DISCIPLINE:

- (1) The administrative control of a trainee during the training period and examination shall rest with the Principal.
- (2) The Principal shall be administrative head and shall be responsible for:—
  - (a) Arrangement and supervision of the course of training/ study.
  - (b) Maintenance of discipline.
  - (c) Conduct of examination.
  - (d) Publication of results.
  - (3) Trainees selected for any course of the training/study shall report to the Principal on the due date of its commencement
- (4) The trainees should abide by the rules and instructions as are in force and any subsequent rules and regulations that may be made from time to time for maintaining discipline in the Training Institute.
- (5) The trainees will have to attend field for practical work regularly before and during office hours as per nature of course.
- (6) The trainee may called back by the Department, if necessary prior to the completion of the training in the public interest.
- (7) The trainces should have his own drawing instruments for regular practice.
- (8) A person selected for training may be allowed exemption from under going the training only twice in his service carrier, provided he can satisfy the authority that his inability to undergo the training is due to some unavoidable and genuine difficulties.

#### 10. POWER TO RELAX:

The State Government in Revenue Department shall have the power to relax any of the provisions of these rules, if it causes undue hardship in its application to a particular person or a group of persons.

Please read as follows below Sub-Rule (9) of Rule 7 of the Tripura Survey and Settlement Training examunation Rules, 1986 published in Tripura Gazette under Notification No. 526-60/F. 2(60)-Accts/84 dated 7th January, 1987.

#### "8 ATTEN DANCE"

A trainee shall be required to attend 93% of the Theoretical and practical classes for qualifying himself to sit for the final examiniation. Relaxation of 2% of attendance may be allowed by the Principal under special circumstances to his satisfaction.
